The starting point is the "Central Station", where we will take a train that goes to "Falls Station" or "Devil's Throat Station". There will be a number of walks to take, that include foot bridges to observe the waterfalls up close. We will visit the Isla San Martín and go aboard Zodiacs to get close to the foot of many

		<p>Perito Moreno Glacier, located in the Glacier National Park 80 km. from the city of Calafate. Upon leaving the city, along the right side of the road, you can see Lake Argentino with Redonda Bay, which offers an interesting variety of bird life. At the entrance to the National Park there is a drastic change in the vegetation which is rich in the special types of trees found in the Patagonian Andes: especially ñires, lengas and cherry trees, among others. During the tour a walk along the paths on the front of the glacier allow a view of this impressive natural marvel from a different perspective. Enjoy lunch at Los Nativos looking over the glacier. At the end of the tour, begin the return to Calafate to arrive at the hotel in the late afternoon. Duration: 8 hours.</p>

		<p>country's most important cultural, cosmopolitan and artistic hub. We start out with a visit to the highpoints of the city's civic center, such as Cerro Santa Lucia (a centrally located historic urban park), the La Moneda Palace (presidential offices) and the traditional Plaza de Armas square, a meeting place for Santiago's diverse and multicultural expressions. Buildings of historical value can be found in the neighborhood, such as the Metropolitan Cathedral, National Museum of History and Central Post Office. We later walk through the Parque Forestal, a park running parallel to the Mapocho River with a variety of tree species offering a refreshing break from the urban agitation of the city's center, and continue on to Barrio Bellavista, Santiago's bohemian neighborhood, with some of the best bars and restaurants in the city. Return to hotel. Duration: 4 hours.</p> <p><i>Meet in the lobby by 2PM with the guide to depart for the tour.</i></p> <p><i>Concha y Toro Winery.</i> Depart from hotel to the Maipo Valley, a region in central Chile better known as the winemaking valley that features the Concha y Toro winery, the country's most important exporter of wine. Concha y Toro welcomes visitors to share its secrets in the winemaking process and exporting activities. The tour includes a walk through the beautifully landscaped colonial grounds of the company founded in 1883. Today it's considered one of the 10 most important in the world of its kind. We'll visit the cellars, the vineyards (some of them started by its founder, don Melchor Concha y Toro) and end with a wine tasting experience at the wine bar before heading back to the hotel. Duration: 4 hours.</p>

Our drive will take you through Casablanca; known for its fine vineyards where we can take a break for a wine-tasting experience. Once we arrive to the coast, we'll first visit Viña del Mar, also known as the "Garden City" because of its beautiful beaches, lovely parks and flower garden landscapes (such as the famous flower clock). It has become one of the central region's most important tourism attractions. The peaceful seascape is an attractive complement for the city's modern streets and infrastructure, turning it into an entertaining hub in constant movement. Enjoy lunch at Restaurant Portofino.</p> <p>Our second destination is the picturesque city-port of Valparaiso, founded in the 16th century. You'll marvel at the contrast between both cities, as the stylishness and beach culture of Viña is replaced here by a much more popular and artistic style. The port was declared by UNESCO a World Heritage Site in 2003 and offers a unique and fascinating architectural</p>
